Dear Danbury Residents,

The City of Danbury is proud to partner with clean energy provider PosiGen to launch the Solar for All program to help bring affordable solar energy and energy efficient upgrades to homeowners across our community, reducing their electric bills and their carbon footprint.

The 25-year solar lease program covers the full cost of insurance, and the installation and maintenance of the solar system. There is no income requirement, no credit score requirement, no money down and no equipment to buy, making the use of solar energy much more accessible for low-and moderate-income residents.

To date over 5,000 Connecticut families and 85 Danbury families participate in the Solar for All program, saving an average of \$650 annually on their energy bills.

Customers receive an energy audit to help deliver savings through weatherization, air sealing, and additional measures. Then, PosiGen installs a solar system customized to produce enough energy to cover your household's needs.

Once the solar panels are installed, customers make a predictable monthly lease payment to PosiGen, which covers all the costs of installing, maintaining, and insuring the system over the 25-year lease.

As a Danbury homeowner, you are eligible for a free home evaluation to determine whether solar power is right for you. PosiGen, PBC is licensed to do business in Connecticut [License numbers HIC.0665487 and ELC.0205499-E1].
